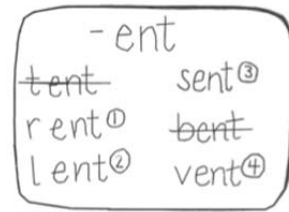


# Word Study Boggle

**Focus Area:** Phonics - building words with target phonetic elements and/or spelling patterns



**Timing:** 5 minutes

**Materials:**

- Dry erase board, marker and eraser for each student
- Timer

**Procedure:**

- Students write as many real words, containing a given phonetic element and/or spelling pattern, on their dry erase boards within a set time limit (e.g., 30 seconds).
- First, have the students write the phonetic element (e.g., /oa/) or spelling pattern (e.g., CVC) on the top of their dry erase boards. You may want them to draw a box around the target phonetic element or spelling pattern.
- Set the timer for 30 seconds and have them begin.
- When time is up, have the students share their words. More specifically, have each student say one word that he/she wrote. As each student says his/her word, the other students check to see if they have the word on their lists. If they do, they cross that word off their lists.
- If no one else has the word, the student who originally stated the word gets one point.
- Continue the activity until every student has had an opportunity to name all the words on his/her list.
